12 days of Christmas

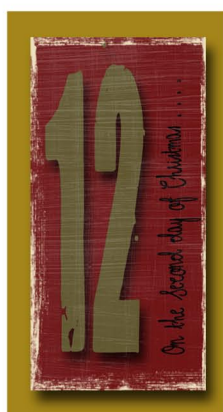
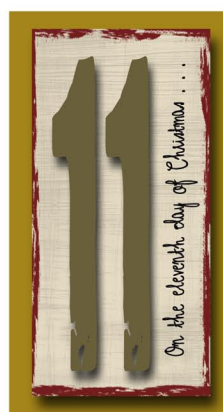
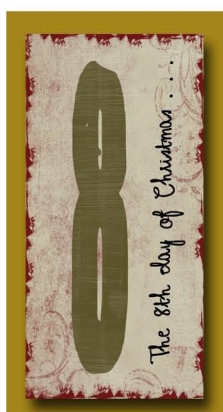
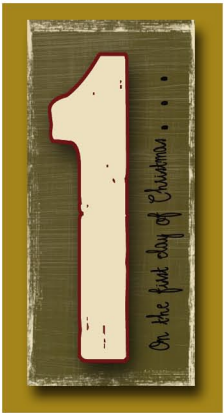


Supplies Needed:

- patterned paper (wasil collection by Basic Grey shown)
- The number pieces below printed and cut
- Misc. embellishments (such as small eyelets, brads, small buttons, rhinestones, snowflakes, poinsetta flowers etc.)
- Black fine point marker (optional for drawing stitching)
- Misc. black alpha stickers
- Dark Brown ink pad (optional for inking the edges)
- 12 Plastic Merit badge pockets (available at the scout-office)
- 12 large buttons for the top of each ornament
- 12 pieces of coordinating ribbon for the loops at the top of the ornaments
- Black thread or floss

Directions:

Trim the pieces to fit into the desired pocket, decorate with patterned paper and embellishments as shown or as you desire. Cover the backs with solid paper if desired, place in plastic pocket, and place an activity card in the back of each pocket. Fold the ribbon pieces (4 to 5 inches) in half and sew on a button through both ends to create a loop. button through the top of the plastic pocket to hang the ornament. On the twelve days before Christmas select the correct numbered ornament and read the desired story, poem, or other activity that is placed in the pocket.
