

CRAFTERS APRON



Supplies Needed:

- Canvas tool belt from Home Depot (around \$0.77)
- 2 pieces of coordinating fabric (enough to cover the front)
- Several scraps of fabric for the flower, or a silk flower (optional)
- Button for the center of the flower (optional)
- Liquid Stitch fabric glue

Directions:

Measure the fabric slightly larger than the apron and turn the edges under to fit exactly inside of the edge seams. Use a hot iron to press, then use fabric glue to secure all of the edges under and adhere to the front of the apron. For a finished look sew a seam down the center and attach a flower to the bottom right corner. For an advanced project, try stitching around the flower or sewing leaves. You can also add ric-rac or various buttons for a fun vintage look.
