

Christmas Coasters



Supplies needed:

- (4) 4.25" square white ceramic tiles (approx. \$0.14 at Home Depot)
- Various Patterned Christmas paper (Imaginisce Snowy Jo shown)
- Decopauge glue
- foam brush
- EnviroTex Lite pour on high gloss finish (purple box) 4oz will make 6



Directions:

Create 4" block patterns out of coordinating Christmas paper. Copy the examples shown or create your own. Use decopauge glue to adhere the blocks to each individual ceramic tile. Let dry completely. Follow the mixing and pouring directions on the box of High gloss finish. They should be dry to touch after about a day. However, they take 72 hours to be completely cured. After they are dried they are water-proof and ready to wrap.



Tips:

- If you are creating several sets you can photocopy the 4" blocks. However, you must use laser copies (the ink from ink jet copies will run.)
- A 4 oz. package of Envirotex Lite High Gloss Finish makes approximately 6 coasters.
