

# Halloween Ornament Tree



## Supplies Needed:

- Empty container (such as Quaker oats can)
  - old tree branches
  - floral moss
- Black spray Paint
- Fabric Canvas
- Glitter
- Decoupage
- Halloween Patterned Paper
- Misc Halloween ribbon
- Iron-transfer paper
- Cardboard (like the back of a cereal box)
- Eyelets
- Crop-a-dile

1. Fill empty canister with floral foam, arrange branches as desired, and cover foam with floral moss.
2. Spray the branches and moss with black spray paint
3. Cover the canister with Halloween Patterned paper and embellishments (check out We R Memory Keeper's new Halloween Line at [shopwer.com](http://shopwer.com))
4. Create ornaments see page 2



# Halloween Tree Ornaments

1. Use the Halloween layered chipboard embellishments from WeR Memory Keepers. Cover the slicker side with patterned paper, set an eyelet at the top, and thread ribbon through.
2. Halloween ornaments the following page onto printable iron-on transfer paper. Follow the directions on the package to iron onto canvas fabric. Trim around design. Adhere to cardboard (a cereal box works great) Apply a thick layer of decoupage, lay flat and dry completely. Apply a thin layer of adhesive to the edges and carefully dip into glitter. When completely dry, attach eyelet at the top with the crop-a-dile. Use thin floral wire to create a hook through the eyelets. Wrap the ends around a thin pen to achieve the curled look.

## Variations:

1. Iron printable designs onto canvas bags to create fun "trick or treat" hand-outs
2. Attach a party invitation to the back of the ornament
3. Use the large design on the printable page to create a one of a kind wall-hanging just follow the same instructions for the ornaments. You can either use wire or ribbon to hang.
4. If you're not interested in iron-on designs then try printing them out on regular paper and decoupage onto chipboard, wood, or metal.

Print this page onto iron-on transfer paper (make sure you select the mirror image print option)  
Alternative: print onto cardstock and decoupage onto canvas, wood or sheet metal.
