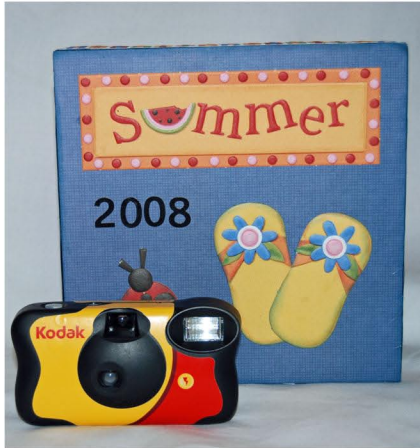


# Summer Collage Ideas
