

Tin Christmas Wall Hanging



Supplies:

- Large piece of sheet metal approx. 36X24 (available at (Home Depot) Will create eight 6X12 wall hangings.
- Coordinating Christmas patterned paper (Basic Gray Figgy Pudding , Making Memories Falala shown)
- Misc. coordinating buttons.
- Chipboard or Wooden Star
- Crop-a-dile (WeR Memory Keepers)
- 2 Large eyelets
- 15 inches of thick ribbon
- Optional: fine black marker, clear glitter, brown ink

Directions:

Measure out eight 6X12 rectangles on the sheet metal. Mark with permanent marker. Cut out sheet metal with a pair or metal shears or a pair of sharp scissors. Round the corners of each piece so they are not sharp. Cut the background paper (musical notes) into 6X12. Adhere onto sheet-metal with decopauge glue. Let dry completely. On a plain piece of 12X6 paper draw a tall triangle (like the tree shape shown). Use this as a pattern for cutting coordinating patterned strips. Use a small piece of brown paper for the trunk. Ink the edges if desired. Use a fine black marker to sketch faux stitching if desired. Adhere onto sheet-metal with decopauge. When dry, brush on a thin layer of decopauge over the entire project. Repeat this step until you achieve the desired finish (letting each layer dry completely). If you would like to add glitter then brush on a thin layer of decopauge over the areas you would like to glitter. Pour on clear glitter and brush off the excess. Add a chipboard or wood star to the top and embellish the tree with misc. coordinating buttons. Punch and set two eyelets at the top using the Crop-a-dile by We R Memory Keepers. Thread ribbon through, tying the ends in the back._
